Robinson CUSD#2 Sickness Policy

If your child is sent home from school after fever, vomiting, or diarrhea, they are excused and should not return for at least 24 hours or until free of symptoms for 24

hours. If your child becomes ill at school you will be called to come and take him/her home from school. It is essential that we have a phone number where you can be contacted during the day and an emergency number in the event you cannot be reached. Please be sure that arrangements can be made to transport your child home from school and that childcare is available in case of illness. If your daytime or emergency phone number changes during the year, please notify the school immediately.

FEVER

Your child should remain home if he/she has had a temperature of 100.0 degrees or higher. A child should have a normal temperature for 24 hours <u>without fever reducing medicines</u> before returning to school.

VOMITING/DIARRHEA

Your child should remain home until free of symptoms for 24 hours.

PINK EYE

Your child may return to school 24 hours after initiation of treatment.

STREP THROAT

Your child may return to school 24 hours after initiation of treatment.

HEAD LICE

Your child should remain home until treated with a pediculicidal agent and cleared by the school nurse. Seven days after treatment a health care provider or school nurse shall re-examine for infestation.

IMPETIGO, SCABIES, OR RINGWORM

Your student should remain home until judged non-infectious by the physician or 24 hours after initiation of treatment.
