

State of Illinois Health Requirements for the 2022-2023 School Year

Students will **NOT** be able to attend school after **October 15, 2022** until **ALL** required information is received.

Requirements by Grade Level:

Preschool Students:

- Physical Exam (Parents please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date)
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor: (4) DTap, (3)Polio, (4)Hib, (3)Hep B, (1)MMR, (1)Varicella, (4)Pneumococcal
- Birth Certificate
- Lead Questionnaire or Lead Screening

Kindergarten Students:

- Physical Exam (Parents please complete the yes/no questions on the back and sign and date)
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor: (5)DTap, (4)Polio, (3)Hep B, (2)MMR, (2)Varicella, (4)Pneumococcal
- Dental Exam on IL form due May 15, 2023(dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)
- Eye Exam on Illinois form dated within one year of the first day of school
- Birth Certificate

Second Grade Students:

- Dental Exam on IL form due May 15, 2023 (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)

Sixth Grade Students:

- Physical Exam (Sports physical NOT acceptable, IL Certificate of Child Health Exam form required) Parents, please complete yes/no questions on the back and sign and date
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor, including **(1)Tdap,(1)Meningitis**-these are 6th-grade requirements
- Dental Exam on IL form due May 15, 2023 (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)

Ninth Grade Students:

- Physical Exam (**Sports physical NOT acceptable**, IL Certificate of Child Health Exam form required)-Parents please complete yes/no questions on the back and sign and date
- Complete immunization record signed by a doctor
- Dental Exam on IL form due May 15, 2023 (dated within 18 months of May 15th deadline)

Twelfth Grade Students:

- Proof of receiving (2)Meningitis: First dose received on or after the 11th birthday and second dose received at least 8 weeks after the first. Only one dose is required if the first dose was received at 16 years of age or older.

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12th Grade

For the **2022-2023** school year any child entering the 12th grade shall show proof of having received two doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccine prior to entering the 12th grade. The first dose shall have been received on or after the 11th birthday, and the second dose shall have been received on or after the 16th birthday, at least eight weeks after the first dose. If the first dose is administered when the child is 16 years of age or older, only one dose is required. Please speak with your child's healthcare provider over the summer regarding your child's vaccination needs. Robinson High School must have documentation of when the vaccine was administered in order for your child to be in compliance with the state of Illinois requirements. The Crawford County Health Department has options available for various forms of insurance/Medicaid.

Proof of receiving the meningitis vaccine must be turned in to the school office no later than October 15, 2022, or your child will face exclusion from school until documentation is received.

October 15, 2022 is the deadline for all required health information!
