## **NEW BUSINESS**

**Presentation of the reorganization Feasibility Study for Hutsonville CUSD #1, Robinson CUSD #2, and Palestine CUSD#3 by the Midwest School Consultants – Dr. William Phillips, Dr. Scott Day, and Dr. Leonard Bogle.**

**Purpose for a Feasibility Study:**

- 1. Provide participating districts with information that can help them determine the best options for students, parents and communities.**
- 2. Provide a neutral viewpoint based on the analysis of curriculum, finances, staff needs, transportation, and facilities.**

**Dr. Scott Day presented the curriculum analysis. Dr. Len Bogle presented the enrollment analysis. Dr. Bill Phillips presented the finance analysis. The consulting firm presented 3 scenarios for the Board:**

- 1. Robinson, Palestine, and Hutsonville consolidate as one unit.**
- 2. Robinson and Palestine consolidate as 1 unit.**
- 3. Hutsonville and Palestine consolidate as 1 unit.**

**The recommendation from Midwest School Consultants was the Hutsonville and Palestine scenario.**

**Questions from the audience were addressed by the presenters from Midwest School Consultants.**
