Administrator Reports:

WES: Positive Behavior Program has been going on the last 3 years. Next Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, for K-1-2 they will make crafts as a reward process for their positive behaviors.

LGS: Students and Staff glad to be back after break. The hockey program started with 160 students attending. Teachers volunteer their time every day after school games. This program
