

RESOLUTION
Robinson CUSD #2 Board of Education
County School Facility Occupation Tax

WHEREAS, Section 5-1006.7 of the Counties Code of the State of Illinois, as amended "County School Facility Occupation tax Law, authorizes the imposition of a tax upon all persons engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property, other than personal property titled or registered with an agency of the government of the State of Illinois, at retail in the County of Crawford, Illinois, on the gross receipts of the sales made in the course of business and a service occupation tax upon all persons engaged in the County in the business of making sales of service, who, as an incident to making those sales of service, transfer tangible personal property within the County as an incident to a sale of service, at a rate of 1% to provide revenue to be used exclusively for school facility purposes if a proposition for the County School Facility Occupation Taxes is submitted to the electors of the County at a regular election and approved by a majority of the electors voting on the Proposition; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of the County School Facility Occupation Tax Law, "*school facility purposes*" means (i) the acquisition, development, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, improvement, financing, architectural planning, and installation of capital facilities consisting of buildings, structures, and durable equipment and the acquisition and improvement of real property and interest in real property required, or expected to be required, in connection with the capital facilities and (ii) the payment of bonds or other obligations heretofore or hereafter issued, including bonds or other obligations heretofore or hereafter issued to refund or to continue to refund bonds or other obligations issued, for school facility purposed provided that the taxes levied to pay such bonds are abated by the amount of the taxes imposed under the County School Facility Occupation tax law that are used to pay such bonds; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of the County School facility Occupation Tax Law, "*school facility purposes*" also includes fire prevention, safety, energy conservation, disabled accessibility, school security, and specified repair purposes set forth under Section 17-2.11 of the School Code of the State of Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the County School Facility Occupation Tax Law provides that upon receipt of a resolution or resolutions of school district boards that represent more than 50% of the student enrollment within the County, the Regional Superintendent of School for the County must certify the Proposition to the proper election authority in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Robinson Community Unit #2, Illinois, deems it necessary, advisable and in the best interest of the District that the Regional Superintendent certify the Proposition to the County Clerk of the County for the submission to the electors of the County at the consolidated election to be held on the 9th day of April, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it and It Is Hereby Resolved by the Board of Education of Robinson Community Unit #2, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Direction to regional Superintendent. The regional Superintendent is hereby directed to certify the Proposition to the County Clerk in the form set forth in the County pay such bonds are School Facility Occupation Tax Law and in accordance with the Election Code, for submission to the electors of the County at the Election.


